Love and Lent

This year, as happens occasionally, Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day fall on the same day.

At first glance there may not seem to be much they hold in common, but the link can be summed up in one word – love.

Not much is known about St Valentine, other than that he was executed in the reign of the Roman Emperor Claudius for converting people to Christianity. One story says that on the night before he died, he wrote a letter to a girl whom he had converted to Christianity and signed it "from your Valentine"; this led to the custom of writing love-letters and sending cards on Valentine's Day.

In his time, married men were excused from fighting in the army, because the Emperor saw wives as a distraction. Legend has it that Valentine married people in secret so they could avoid army service, which antagonised the authorities, and associated Valentine with love.

For Christians, Lent too is about love – responding to the love of God by self-discipline and prayer. This aspect often gets overshadowed by the idea of penitence and fasting, which can turn Lent into a time of misery and deprivation rather than one which has love at its heart. But even the penitence and fasting have a positive purpose – to get back to basics with one's relationship with God and to be people for whom God's love is the most important part of life.

In the temptations in the wilderness, Jesus responded three times that loving God was the most important thing, above satisfying physical desires (turning stones into bread), worshipping others (worshipping the tempter) and testing God (jumping off the Temple). Each time he was tempted, he responded by putting God first.

When we love, we aim to put the other first. Lent is a time that helps Christians to put God first in everything – hence the tradition of giving up things that distract us from that. Rather than a negative time of deprivation, it is a positive attempt to grow in faith and trust.

Lent also teaches us how to live out the love of God in practical ways, as we follow Jesus in the in the way of the Cross. We see this clearly demonstrated in the life and death of Saint Valentine.





Month on the Farm



With all the wet weather we have been having, the cattle in the sheds have had to have copious amounts of straw as bedding to keep them dry. The combination of muck, damp straw and the mild weather is a recipe for the pneumonia bugs to breed and infect the cattle. To try to alleviate the need to treat the cattle we regularly clean all the muck and straw out of the sheds before it heats up too much. The muck is hauled to various locations and tipped in the field. This has

needed a bit of planning as to where we go or if we are not careful a lot of mud can be carried back out on the roads which then needs the bucket brush to clean up.

The wet weather has obviously meant some very waterlogged soils with the meadows flooding, which is normal in winter. But some of the autumn sown cereal crops are patchy where the seed is rotted or eaten by the slugs, some fields will need a bit of patching up when the weather improves.



We have moved some of the malting barley, which was cut in August and kept in the grain store with just some air blown through the heap to make sure the grains do not deteriorate, if there is any drop in the grain germination then we get a penalty price wise. The lorries took the grain to Poole where it was loaded straight onto a boat with one load getting a £4/tonne deduction. Some of the wheat has moved off and been taken to Cullumpton to be processed for cattle feed. Over the past 12 months the grain price has altered considerably as below:



On 22 February we will host a live music night with Daisy Chute and James Walker, tickets available via wegottickets.com



Unite branch commemorate anniversary of Tolpuddle Martyrs arrest

Before sunrise on the 24th February 1834 farm worker George Loveless left for work - it would be 3 years before he would be back with his wife and children again.

George, and five fellow workers - James Brine, James Hammett, James Loveless, John Standfield and Thomas Standfield - were arrested, charged with making an illegal oath and transported to Australia. They only returned following a public outcry over their treatment. Though the real reason for their treatment was that they had made a stand against poor pay and wage cuts by forming a trade union.

To commemorate the 190th anniversary of the arrest of George Loveless and the Tolpuddle Martyrs the Unite Tolpuddle Branch, which represents food, drink, agricultural and transport workers across Dorset, will be holding a free event in the Village Hall.

The Martyrs Arrest 190 event will be a chance to hear speakers highlight the links between the Martyrs story and the experience of workers today and listen to music from local socialist choir, Dorset Red, and singer songwriter Neil Duncan-Jordan.

Unite event organisers are also in touch with a project in Canada, where most of the arrested Martyrs settled after gaining their freedom, that is in the process of restoring George Loveless grave in his final resting place of London, Ontario. It is hoped that this group will talk about the project via zoom.

Former farmworker and Unite Branch Chair John Burbidge said: "The arrests were calculated to create fear and isolation after pay cuts that left workers unable to feed and house their families. Today the government is using the law again to stop workers resisting the massive hit to our living standards for the sake of the same unbridled greed of the same class."

Unite South West Deputy Regional Secretary Donna Williams will be speaking at the event and said: "As we reflect on the Tolpuddle Martyrs legacy, the struggles of the past continue to resonate with the challenges workers face today as we continue to fight for jobs, pay and conditions."

The event takes place in Tolpuddle Village Hall on Saturday 24th Feb from 12.30 to 3.00 pm.



As the thank you letters below show just £250 can make all the difference.


